## **Details of Scheme**

This is the annual report for the Select KiwiSaver scheme (**Scheme**) for the year to 31 March 2022. The Scheme is a KiwiSaver scheme.

The Scheme's manager is Smartshares Limited (**Smartshares**), which is a wholly owned subsidiary of NZX Limited. The Scheme's supervisor is Public Trust.

The latest product disclosure statement for the Scheme is dated 15 December 2021. The Scheme is open for applications.

The latest fund updates for the Scheme are dated 3 May 2022.
